For relatively straight forward edit descriptions and edit words, the conversion is faithful. However, it is possible to create edit descriptions and edit words for which there is no faithful conversion. In particular, if yours is a system that uses decimal format 'I' or 'J' (comma used as the decimal format), and if you are using the user defined edit codes 5-9, and if the edit descriptions remain as originally shipped by IBM (period as the decimal point), the commas separating thousand groups are not suppressed by insignificant digits. Previously, we used the IBM definitions
